The Nora bath spouts are intended for use with hot & cold water in residential & commercial applications. Both models are & have G 1/2" inlets that are compatible with GB 1/2" metallic supply fittings.

Conditions of Use

The Nora bath spouts must be installed by a registered plumber in accordance with the supplied instructions and in compliance with the relevant requirements of AS/NZS 3500.

The water supply pipes must be flushed thoroughly to remove any debris. In-line water filters must be used.

The maximum permitted temperature of water at the outlet is 50 degrees Celsius.

This product is cleanable and impervious to moisture. Cleaning shall be done in accordance with the supplied cleaning instructions.
